

If you are traveling out of the State or Country and you need to take your Credit Union financed vehicle with you, County Schools asks for your safety and security you take certain steps prior to your departure.

Following these steps will help insure a smooth transition from the time of your request to the time of acceptance by the Credit Union, and ensure that you receive the proper service that you have come to expect as a member of County Schools Federal Credit Union.

- 1.) You must write a letter explaining where you are going, and when you will return (please be advised the Credit Union does not allow for vehicles to be removed for more than a thirty day period of time)
- 2.) You must have proper proof of California insurance
- 3.) You must have proof of current registration
- 4.) On out of country requests you must provide proof of an out of country insurance policy as well. I.E. Mexican insurance if you are traveling to Mexico.
- 5.) Your account must be in good standing with the Credit Union at the time of the request and should have been open with the Credit Union at least twelve months prior to submitting this request.

Please be advised that these requests are subject to Credit Union approval and should be submitted to the Credit Union at least thirty days prior to your departure time. Once approved ALL signers must be present in the Credit Union to sign a formal out of country/state agreement that must be kept in the vehicle the entire duration of your trip.

Please be advised that should you fail to notify the Credit Union that you are removing the vehicle without the Credit Unions prior written consent your account could be subject to default under the terms and conditions of your contract with the Credit Union.
